SUBJECT: Tuberculosis Examination

Maryland State Law requires that all school employees be certified as free from tuberculosis in a communicable stage. "Employees" is defined to include all personnel whether they are permanent temporary, paid or voluntary, regularly employed or substituting, or full-time or part-time. The certification process requires screening of school employees on initial employment and subsequently at intervals specified by the local Health Officer. Certification of freedom from tuberculosis must be by a licensed physician or a health agency.
